Course overview

This is the next stage course for learners who have completed their entry 1 qualification and now want to progress to start learning entry 2 level ESOL. Entry level learners to continue their local ESOL classes. Before you can join the course, your English skills will be checked with a short test so that the tutor can make sure that the class is right for you. This course is for people with little English. You do not need any ESOL qualifications to join.

Course description

The course will add to the previous course and is designed for those learners who have basic English language at the moment and they will be tested before enrolment to make sure that they are on the correct course for their level. The course is designed to help empower learners to find more independence by being a step closer gaining employment. The course will be run face to face in a local friendly community venue where learners will be taught in a classroom by a qualified tutor. The classes will have a mixture of activities including activities to enhance their confidence through the learning f the essential skills such as speaking, listening, reading and writing. The course offered is unaccredited, however it is hoped that it can progress learners towards an accredited qualification.
