Course overview

Emphasis will be placed on cultivating a deeper connection with one's surroundings, embracing curiosity, and honing the ability to see the extraordinary in the ordinary.

Course description

This course is designed to inspire and empower photographers of all levels to discover new sources of creativity and develop their personal vision. Through a combination of lectures, hands-on shooting assignments, group discussions, and critiques, participants will explore various techniques and approaches for finding inspiration in their photography practice. assignments and projects.
