Course overview

Have you learnt the basics of painting in watercolours and are looking for fresh ideas? Why not join this course, explore your own creativity and find new inspiration? Do you want to learn different methods for painting flowers, trees and other seasonal Summer scenes? This six week Summer themed course aims to provide lots of ideas and techniques for working spontaneously and expressively. You will have the opportunity to explore a variety of approaches to painting as well as sharing ideas and taking part in weekly discussions about your artworks with the tutor and other students on the course.

Course description

This 6-week course is aimed at intermediate level students and will introduce you to different Summer themed inspirations for painting in watercolour and help you to explore methods for working spontaneously and expressively.

Sessions will contain ideas for exploring self-expression and encourage you to try out new ways of approaching your own paintings and all with a Summer theme including flowers, trees, shells and scenery. There will be the opportunity to see and take inspiration from a variety of sources including books, handouts, photographs, personal sketchbooks and artists as well as ideas that emerge during the sessions.

Weekly vocal discussions will take place at the start of each of the sessions where you will have the chance to be involved in the sharing of ideas and constructive feedback about your artworks with the tutor and other students on the course.

Teaching will include the use of a variety of creative prompts, demonstrations, downloadable handouts and other relevant online resources on Canvas and the Internet. Discussion groups on Canvas will also be made available for you to upload images of your artworks to and receive written encouragement and comments from the tutor and other students on the course.

Options you might want to take-up after this course, include a further follow on intermediate watercolour course.
