Course overview

Course description

The course will also cover how to recognise and challenge prejudice or divisive behaviour in a respectful and impactful way. By the end of the course, learners will feel confident in their ability to influence positive change and promote peace in their communities. They will leave with actionable ideas for fostering unity and inclusion, along with practical tools for being a role model of peaceful advocacy. This course is ideal for anyone who wants to contribute to a more cohesive and understanding society while building their own communication and leadership skills.
