- Polish your listening skills in conversations and recorded audio situations
- Respond to detailed questions on a range of topics and cover several points in your reply
- Learn to make requests and ask for information in unfamiliar situations
- Recognise which modal verb to use in responses to suggestions and criticisms.

This is an ESOL skills for life level 2 speaking and listening course. You will continue to develop your verbal communication skills.

You need some prior knowledge to take this course, that's why you'll do a skills check to enrol. Don't worry, this isn't an exam. It's for us to make sure you get on the right course for you.

Our friendly team will contact you to start your skills check as part of your booking.

When you complete this module, you can continue with other ESOL skills for life level 2 courses. This is the highest level ESOL qualification we offer. There are also writing and reading courses.

There are "Get Ready" courses between each module to prepare you for the next course.
