Grow your vocabulary and improve your reading skills in English. There are also writing and speaking & listening courses at this level. If you're helping others find ESOL courses in the UK, you've come to the right place.

Course description

What we'll cover

- Learn to use a dictionary to explore new and unfamiliar vocabulary in English
- Understand and follow written instructions and directions
- Read and understand how to fill out forms asking for personal information

- Understand the main points of a text talking about events or instructions
- Read and be able to explain who a text is aimed at and what it's about

This is an English course for adults. You will work on developing your reading skills.

You need foundational reading skills to take this course, that's why you'll need to do a skills check to enrol. Don't worry, this isn't an exam. It's for us to make sure you get on the right course for your level.

Our friendly team will contact you to start your skills check as part of your booking.

When you complete this module, you can continue with other entry 2 ESOL courses. Once you finish the reading, writing, and speaking & listening courses, you can progress to entry 3 level.

There are also "Get Ready" courses between each module to prepare you for the next course.

This ESOL skills for life entry 2 reading course takes around 90 hours to complete.
