Role Overview

A WEA Ambassador advocates the work, vision and mission of the WEA, drawing on personal experience to introduce the WEA to new people. They will particularly support our Fundraising and Campaigns work.

The WEA will provide support, information, and guidance where needed and work in partnership with you to raise the profile of the WEA and of adult education.

A good Ambassador is someone who can talk informally, passionately and realistically about the challenges and rewards of studying as an adult. You will be passionate about ensuring our campaigns reach as many new audiences as possible, and that we are able to continue to fund our work across England and Scotland.

What do Ambassadors do?

You will use your time and networks to raise the profile of the WEA by supporting our campaigns, talking to your communities about our work and letting others know the different ways to support us.

The WEA Ambassador role is designed to complement your everyday working and social activity. We aim for activities that can help you make an impact, within the time you can offer.

We will provide a variety of suggestions for how to get involved, and you can let us know what suits you, and let us know when you are available and when you aren't. In 2021 and 22 we will be developing the Ambassador role and we would appreciate everyone's input and feedback throughout this process.

There will be four Ambassador meetings a year (all on zoom) and we request Ambassadors attend or feed into at least two.
