Do not share:

- ▶ Your email address
- ▶ Telephone number
- ▶ Passwords
- ▶ Use strong different passwords for accounts
- ▶ Use a password manager, (e.g. the Microsoft Edge password manager)
- ▶ Use 2-step verification (a password and a code sent to your phone)
- ▶ Always log out of websites once you've finished
- ▶ Lock your device
- ▶ Set privacy settings on social media
- ▶ Never open files or click on links you did not expect to receive
- ▶ If in doubt, block. Just say no to invitations from people you don't know
