**From Leeds Bradford Airport .....**

Outside the arrivals at Leeds Bradford Airport you will find the **bus 757** stop, direction Leeds City Centre and Railway Station, leaving every 30 min. The ticket costs £3.80 (one way) and can be purchase on-board. At Leeds Railway Station you can catch a **train to Hull** taking up to 1 hour. The standard train ticket can be purchased at the ticket desk or online [www.thetrainline.com](http://www.thetrainline.com) and it costs between 6£ and 20£.

It is of course also possible to fly into any of the London airports and travel to Hull via train (2hrs30-3hrs from King's Cross). Hull Trains operate direct train services from London Kings Cross to Hull.
